

Twitter – The Basics of Signing up and Following

I have been asked to provide more detailed instructions for signing up for Twitter and also for following PBI on Twitter.

This article will provide the instruction that you need to assist you.

1. Go to www.twitter.com



2. Click on Sign up now and create an account.
