

Facebook – How to Sign up and Become a Fan of PBI

1. Go to www.facebook.com and fill in the “sign up” information.





2. Click on Sign Up and complete the security check.





4. Skip or save on the next two steps, as you prefer. These steps involve putting in basic profile information and a picture for your profile.

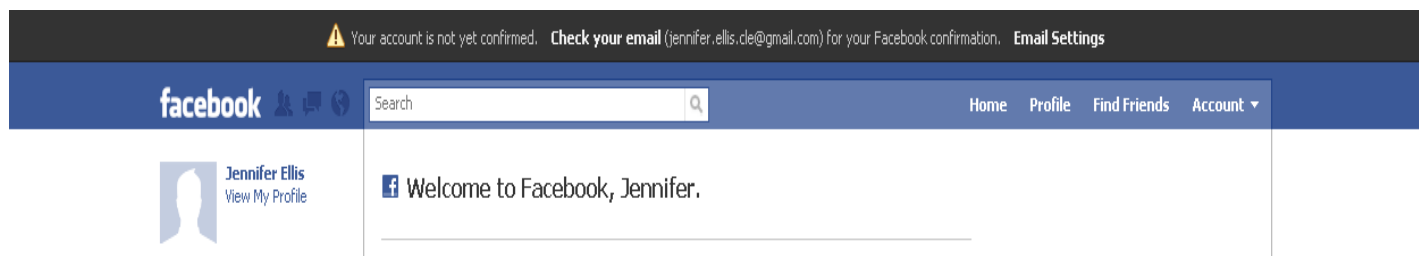

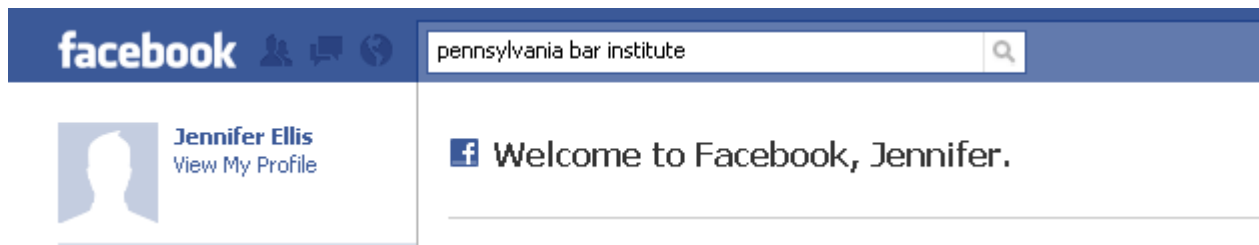

7. Click on the link to confirm, you will be taken to your Facebook account and will see a popup window informing you that your account has been confirmed.

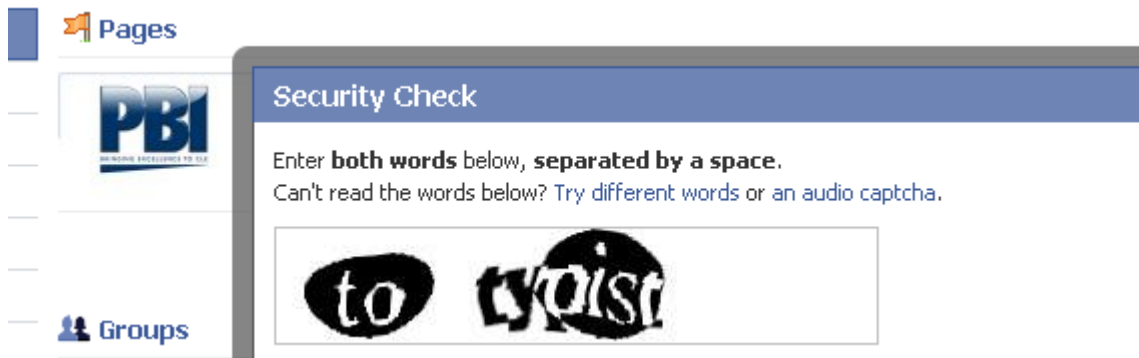
8. Go to the search box at the top of the screen and type in Pennsylvania Bar Institute



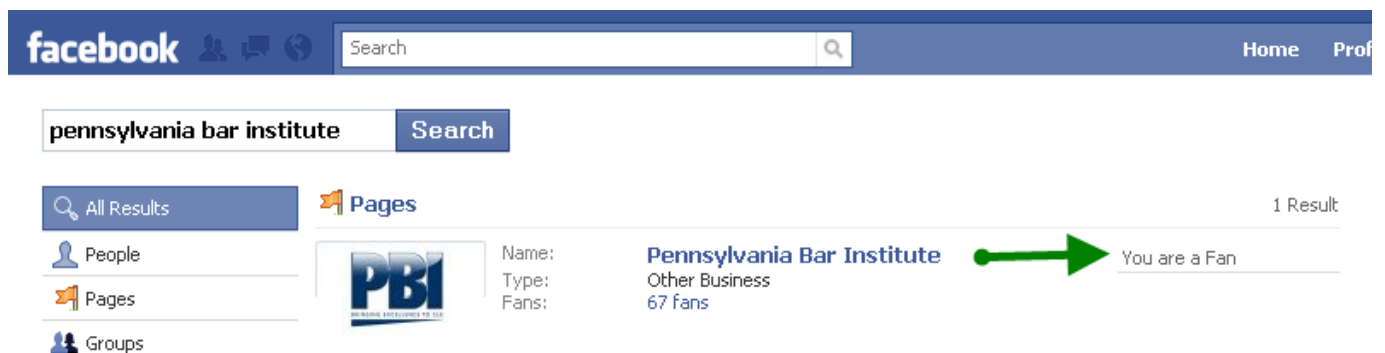
9. The search results will include PBI's Facebook page. Click on Become a Fan
